New Vocabulary This Week: Lección 1 Verbs p. 3

New Common Words and Phrases This Week (p.iii): ¿Cómo se llama él/ella?, Se llama_____, por favor, gracias, de nada, no entiendo, repite por favor, perdóname

Day 1:

- Make flashcards for new common words and phrases above. Listen to them on the audio. Review them every day along with the ones from last week.
- Read Lección 1 Los verbos p. 3 with audio.
- Do Learning Your New Verbs p. 3. For now, just practice the "I" and "we" forms (lavo, lavamos, abro, abrimos, barro, barremos, estoy, estamos).
- Quick review your Lección 1 vocabulary flashcards - have someone quiz you out loud.
- ***Optional:** Requiz vocabulary - this time have the person say the words to you in English. You write them in Spanish. Then check your spelling.
- ***Optional:** Play Matamoscas to practice Lección 1 vocabulary. Go to www.spanish-for-you.net, Curriculum Activities for instructions. Fun for 2 or more people.

Day 2:

- Review Lección 1 Los verbos p. 3 with audio.
- Review your "I" and "we" verb forms by putting those flashcards in groups together.
- Now, put your other verb flashcards in groups - "you", "he/she/you formal", "you all (Spain)", and "they/you all". Keep these out as you do the worksheet that comes next.
- Do L1 Los verbos G5-6 worksheet. If it seems like a lot, don't worry, you will catch on with time. Just do your best!
- ***Optional:** Play 16 Square Bingo to practice verbs. Fill in squares in Spanish using "I" and "we" forms, the un-conjugated forms (abrir, lavar, barrer, estar), and the command forms (lava, abre, barre, está). Have someone call off the words in English. See Games and Activities section in your book for instructions.

Day 3:

- Read El alfabeto p. ii with audio.
- Play Hangman (see Games and Activities section in book) using Lección 1 vocabulary. Guess the letters using the Spanish alphabet.
- Review your verb flashcards and put them in their groups. Notice patterns!
- Have someone quiz you on the "I" and "we" groups. Do more groups if you feel ready.

Day 4:

- Do L1 Verbos y vocabulario G5-6 worksheet.
- Review the Spanish alphabet p. ii with audio.
- Pay attention to the sound of the letters "j" and "ñ". "J" always sounds like "h", and "ñ" always sounds like "ny".
 - Examples: el jardín, el garaje, el baño

- ***Optional:** Play 16 Square Bingo to practice the Spanish letters. Fill in the boxes on your Bingo card with any of the Spanish letters, one letter per box. Have someone call the letters out in Spanish while players mark the letters on their squares.

- ***Optional Extra Worksheet** for Experienced** Spanish for You! students. Do L1 Verbos más avanzados G5-6 worksheet.
