I Spy

To play "I Spy" in Spanish is really easy. Here is how it goes:

- A person says, "Veo _____." (filling in the blank with a Spanish word.)
 - For example: "Veo el libro." (I see the book.)
- The other person looks for it and points to it or touches it.
- You can do this in so many ways:
 - Use a book or picture filled with lots of items where you can look for vocabulary you have learned in Spanish.
 - You can play in a room in your house looking for things to "I Spy".
 - You can play in the car on a long ride.
 - You can play while in a restaurant, store, library, anywhere where there is "stuff"!
 - If you are using Spanish for You!, use your book to give you vocabulary ideas. It is such a lightweight book, take it with you in the car or elsewhere!
- If you want to play a little more advanced game, you could do this:
 - A person says, "Veo algo rojo." (I see something red.)
 - Other person looks for the item in that color or colors, touches or points to it, and says what it is in Spanish.
 - If you know other describing adjectives in Spanish you can be a little more specific. Like: "Veo algo rojo y grande." (I see something red and big.)

Pronunciation Help:

veo (I see) = beh-oh

algo (something) = ahl-go
