Matamoscas (Swat the flies)

Number of Players: 2 or more.

Materials Needed: 2 flyswatters, dry-erase/chalkboard, dry-erase markers or chalk, vocabulary picture cards (optional)

Instructions:

- Players are divided into 2 teams.
- Board is divided in half with a line down the middle.
- On each side of the board write words in Spanish with space in between each word. Or tape up vocabulary pictures.
- The two sides of the board should be duplicates of each other.
- One person calls out a word in English. This person is not on either team. If you are using vocabulary pictures, call out the words in Spanish.
- One person from each team swats the picture or word in Spanish on their side of the board with a flyswatter.
- The first player to "swat" the correct word or picture gets a point for their team.
- Play up to a designated number of points. The team to reach that number of points first wins.

matamoscas (mah-tah-moe-skahs) = flyswatter or "Swat the flies."
