Activity	Instructions	Materials
Warm up: Greet Students <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ¿Cómo estás?, ¿Cómo te llamas? in pairs • ¿Cómo se llama él/ella? • Introduce ¿De dónde eres? Soy de_____. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Greet the students, "Hola, ¡Buenos días! or ¡Buenas tardes! • Students ask and answer in pairs, ¿Cómo estás? and ¿Cómo te llamas? • Randomly ask, ¿Cómo se llama él/ella? Students raise hands to answer. • Point to and say, "¿De dónde eres?" Students repeat. • Say, "Soy de_____." Students repeat. • Answer question and see if they guess meaning. • Practice asking and answering round robin. 	<p>Have questions and answers on board.</p> <p>Each week have ¿Cómo se dice____? Se dice_____ written on your board so students can use in class.</p>
Lesson Begins: Alphabet Review Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read the alphabet aloud together from books. • Quick review vowels. • Talk about "ll" sound. Think of words together that use "ll" • Quick review sounds of "j, ñ. 	Spanish for You! books
Listening "hay", indef. articles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students listen to sentences below and say "sí or no" if they would be true. 	sentences below
Introduce Lección 2 Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read Lección 2 Vocabulary from book p. 11 aloud. Students repeat each word. • Have students raise hands to change each word to use an indefinite article. • See if students can say some sentences using "hay" and new vocabulary. • Pass out flashcards. Have students get up, move around room asking for someone else's flashcard using, "por favor, gracias, de nada". 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spanish for You! books • Lección 2 vocabulary flashcards *Remind students the meaning of "hay".
Play Hangman in Pairs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Play Hangman in pairs to guess new words using Spanish letters. • Pass out dry erase squares and markers, or use scrap paper. • Students can leave books open to p. 11 and can look at alphabet p. ii. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spanish for You! books • dry erase squares • dry erase markers
Review Lección 1 Verbs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Together conjugate verbs "top/down". Write on board as students say.
