Around the World

Number of Players: 2 or more and one extra person to show flashcards.

Materials needed:

- Any group of your flashcards with vocabulary or verbs written in English or Spanish or just showing pictures.

Instructions:

- Two players stand side by side.
- The extra person shows a flashcard and the first player to say it in Spanish (if it's a picture or written in English) or English (if written in Spanish), moves on to challenge the next player in the room.
- **In the case of small groups (3 to 4 players)** the one who wins the match keeps the card and moves to the next person. The winner of that match keeps the card and moves to challenge the next person, and so on. Players continue to move "Around the World" challenging each other until you come to the end of the flashcards. Player with the most cards wins.
- **In the case of a large group (5 or more players)** game is played same as with small group, but rather than keep the cards, players simply move "Around the World" (around the room) until they make it back to their original spot. When players lose a match they remain in the place of where they lost the match, until play comes around to them again. The player who makes it all the way around back to their original spot wins. Sometimes it is good to modify the game so a player must make it twice around before winning.

Variations:

- **In the case of 2 players**, the player who says the meaning first keeps the flashcard. The one with the most cards at the end wins the game.
- **Another variation for 2 players:** Lay the cards out around the room face down. Both players go to the first card. The third person turns it over. The first player to say it keeps the card. They continue to move "around the world" until they get through the cards. Player with the most cards wins.
